UCLA Early Academic Outreach Program

The Early Academic Outreach Program (EAOP) is a pre-college academic preparation program established in 1976 by the University of California to expand postsecondary education opportunities for California’s educationally and economically disadvantaged students. The informational outreach component of EAOP, serves targeted high schools that are not a part of our full service EAOP schools. Informational schools receive monthly or twice a semester services and student data is not entered in our database.

Informational Outreach High School Service Model

The goal of the Informational Based Component of the UCLA Early Academic Outreach Program is to inform students and their parents of the college options and requirements high school students need in order to apply to the colleges of their choice. What staff will do in informational schools is provide workshops on various college related topics. Informational high school personnel will be responsible for making all arrangements, promotion, notification, and invitation to students for the EAOP staff to conduct these workshops in classrooms or in assembly formats. Moreover, eligible students will be invited to participate in Saturday academies or other college related events on the UCLA campus. College preparatory presentations in large general assembly, classroom presentations or small group sessions by grade level (9th, 10th, 11th and 12th) will include but are not limited to the following topics by grade level:

9th & 10th Grades:

- General College Prep Presentations at school Site, with topics including:
 - UC ‘A-G’ Academic Requirements
 - Four Systems of Higher Education
 - Financial Aid
 - College entrance exams (SAT, ACT, etc.)
 - Academic Planning: how to develop individual academic plans
- Parent Meetings and Workshops

11th Grade

- General College Prep Presentation at school Site
 - Jr. Assessment Workshop
 - Financial Aid/Scholarship and personal statement workshops
 - College entrance exams (SAT, ACT, etc.)
- Parent Meetings and Workshops

12th Grade – Same as 11th Grade, in addition:

- UC/CSU Application and personal statement workshops
- Financial Aid: specific advising on Financial Aid, Scholarship, completing the FAFSA
- College entrance exams (SAT, ACT, etc.)
- Community College Transfer Information
